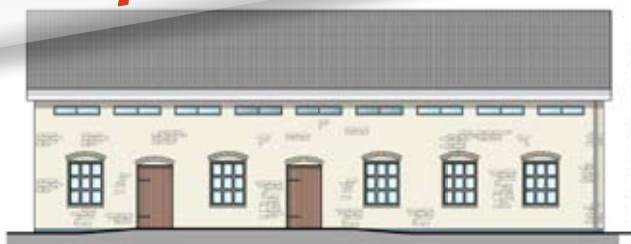

The reconstruction of the former Mill Barn at Over Basin is planned to provide a desperately needed support resource for the Herefordshire & Gloucestershire Canal Trust.

Please help us to make this possible.

The foundations for the Mill Barn to replace the current shipping containers and site hut will start soon. The barn will provide a much improved volunteer mess room, disabled WC facilities, storage and a much needed base for the expanding Canal-wide maintenance team. The large loft space will provide a crucial meeting and training room, and hugely improved open plan office space for the **Legal & Project Development Team**.

The facilities will be available for the regular users of Over Basin like **Over Fishing Club, Gloucester and District Model Boat Club** and the **Sailig4Disabled**.

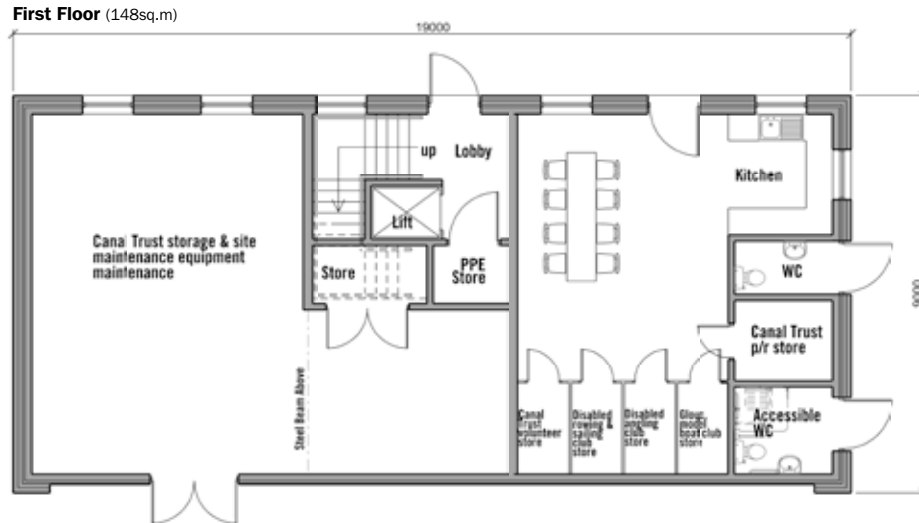
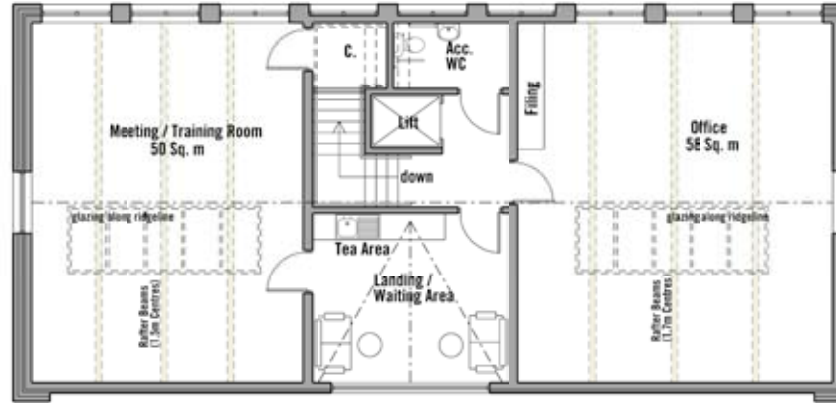
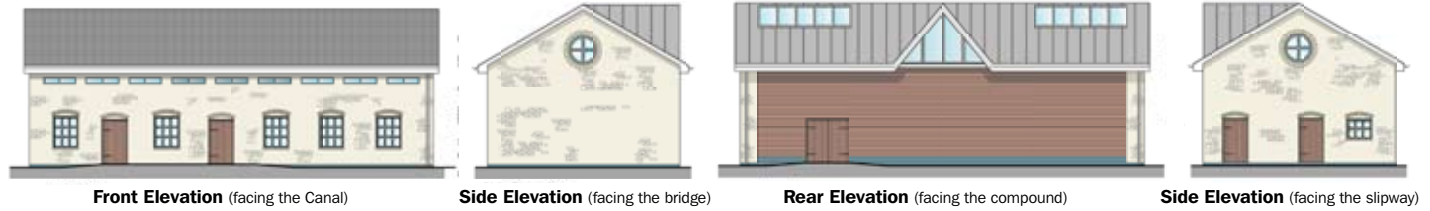

Volunteer Facilities

Mill Barn will greatly benefit the work of the volunteers carrying out the restoration and maintenance of the Canal. It will provide a workshop for maintenance of the boats and equipment. The Barn will also provide a much needed storage space for tools as well as larger equipment.
